The Miller Centre Club Membership Application Form – Guidance Notes

Membership

Each membership can cover up to two people living at the same address - they do not have to be related to one another. The first named person is the "Principal Member" and the other a "Joint Member". All are eligible for the same membership benefits - these include the use of the facilities at The Miller Centre, participation in the many daytime leisure activities (some groups make a small additional charge), a periodic Newsletter and advance booking of tickets for events in the theatre, such as films and plays.

Age Limits

Membership of the Miller Centre Club is open to anyone aged 18 or over, and there is no upper age limit. However Club Rules state that the majority of Members at any time should be aged 50 or over, so we ask that you indicate your age range on the Application Form. You can choose not to provide this information.

Newsletters

Newsletters are normally sent by email. If the Principal Member does not have an email address they can opt to collect printed Newsletters from the Miller Centre. Each Newsletter will give the date upon which the next one will be available for collection (from the A-Z pigeon holes in the Green Room, by the Box Office door). Members can also opt out of receiving Newsletters if they wish.

Volunteer Activities

All Members are encouraged to participate in running our resident Community Theatre or daytime Leisure Activities by volunteering their time; this can be as little as an hour or so per month, or up to several days, depending upon individuals' availability and skills. This broad range of activities require people with skills such as organisational, clerical, customer service, administration, IT, carpentry, painting & needlework, or production support skills like sound, lighting, stage management & props. Whilst it is not mandatory to volunteer, members are encourage to do so if they have the necessary skills - or willingness to learn - and physical ability.

Some roles are purely daytime, others are required during evenings (i.e. when there is a production in the Theatre). Our Volunteer Coordinator will contact you to discuss your skills and availability and, if you are willing, will introduce you to an appropriate team. In all cases full training will be provided.
